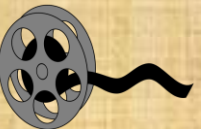

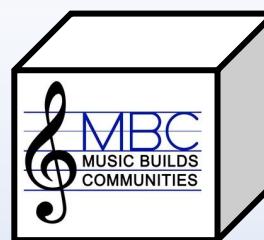

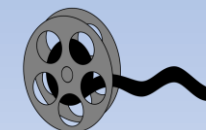

**The 7th Century Anglo-Saxon Cemetery  
in Exning and its Setting**



During 2012, in preparation for a new housing estate off Burwell Rd Exning, a series of ancient remains were discovered.

In total there were 20 Anglo-Saxon graves found containing 21 skeletons and a series of intriguing grave goods.

Through the analysis carried out by the archeologists who investigated the site, we can build a picture of what life was like for these mid 7th century people and the political environment in which they lived.

## Exning Community Church Hall– ECCH Events Email List Data Protection Policy & GDPR

The GDPR, the General Data Protection Regulation, has been in operation since May 2017 and is enforceable from 25th May 2018.

Exning Community Church Hall (ECCH) will comply with the requirements of GDPR in the following way:

- 1) Information about you/ Why we need this data
  - a) What data will we collect
    - i) Required: Your name and email address – to keep you informed of events at ECCH (e.g. Exning Village Cinema, Concerts, Plays, new activities etc)
    - ii) If volunteered by you:
      - (1) Your phone number/in case of cancellations
      - (2) Your location (e.g. town)/to enable lift sharing if requested
  - b) Where and how it is stored;
    - i) In a Gmail address book "ECCH Events" with password control
  - c) Who can view it / what they can view;
    - i) The DPO (Data Protection Officer)/ all information you provided
    - ii) Another person designated by the ECCH Committee/ all information you provided
    - iii) Emails to the distribution list will be sent using "bcc" to prevent your email being shared.
- 2) You may provide data in a number of formats e.g. on paper, on line, etc and may have a copy of this policy by request to the DPO (email DPO@exningcommunitychurchhall.org)
- 3) The DPO (Data Protection Officer) for ECCH is John Saville
- 4) You have the right to:
  - a) Be removed from the list etc; but this will affect your ability to learn of activities at ECCH.
  - b) See what information we store about you, by request to the DPO, and we will provide this within one month.
  - c) Have your data deleted
  - d) Change details of the data
- 5) The data will not be shared with others.
- 6) We will retain the information until you request its deletion or for a period of 3 months after ECCH ceases to be used for events.
