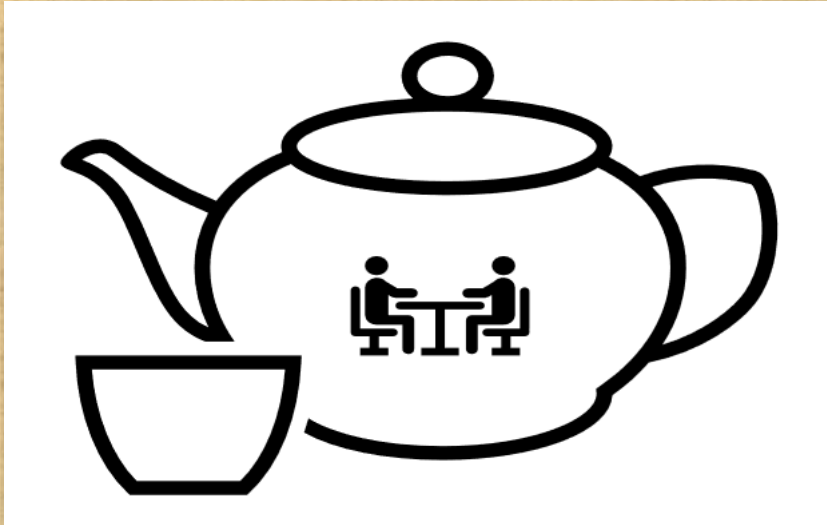
This all-squeezing, cake-loving, tea (and wine!) drinking band of talented ladies has enthralled audiences across the country.

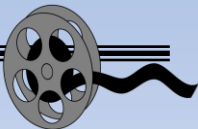

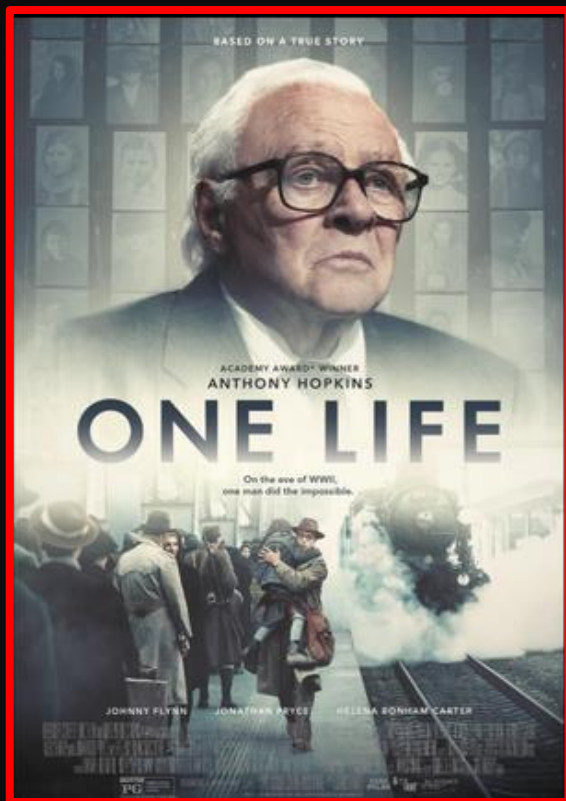

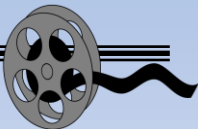
