Data Protection Policy & GDPR

The GDPR, the General Data Protection Regulation, has been in operation since May 2017 and is enforceable from 25th May 2018.

Exning Community Church Hall (ECCH) will comply with the requirements of GDPR in the following way:

- 1) Information about you/ Why we need this data
 - a) What data will we collect
 - i) Required: Your name and email address – to keep you informed of events at ECCH (e.g. Exning Village Cinema, Concerts, Plays, new activities etc)
 - ii) If volunteered by you:
 - (1) Your phone number/in case of cancellations
 - (2) Your location (e.g. town)/to enable lift sharing if requested
 - b) Where and how it is stored;
 - i) In a Gmail address book "ECCH Events" with password control
 - c) Who can view it / what they can view:
 - i) The DPO (Data Protection Officer) / information you provided
 - ii) Another person designated by the ECCH Committee; all information you provide
 - iii) Emails to the distribution list will be sent "blind" to prevent your email being viewed.
- 2) You may provide data in a number of formats e.g. paper, on line, etc and you will receive a copy of this policy by request to the DPO (email DPO@exningcommunitychurchhall.org)
- 3) The Data Protection Officer for ECCH is John Saville
- 4) You have the right to:
 - a) Be removed from the list but this will affect your ability to learn of activities at ECCH.
 - b) See what information we store about you. Request to the DPO, and we will provide this within one month.
 - c) Have your data deleted
 - d) Know the details of the data
 - e) Your data will not be shared with others.

We will retain the information until you request its deletion or for a period of 3 months after ECCH ceases to be used for events.
